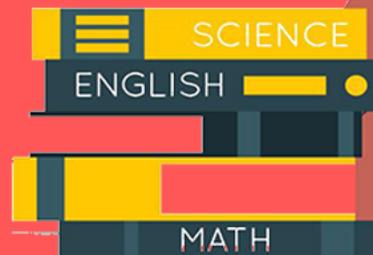

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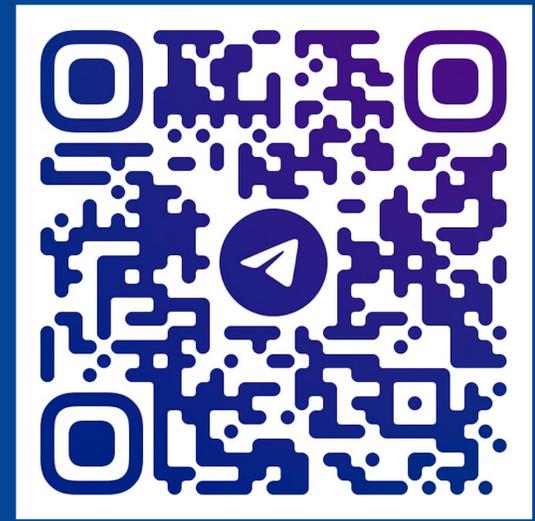
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

💡 Rule 1

Consider only the matter which is given in the statements. **Do not add** anything from your side.



Rule 2

Avoid presumptions



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


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
