1. Remove 'suddenly' as its usage on here is superfluous because 'come across' itself means 'to meet suddenly'.
2. Use 'of' after 'taken care'.
3. Remove 'kindly' as 'Kindly' & 'Requested' can't be used together because Kindly, itself is used to make a request in Active Voice which is being used as a 'Request' in Passive Voice.
4. Remove 'by all' as its use is superfluous on here. 'Universally' in itself means accepted by all or acknowledged by all.
5. Use of 'near' is superfluous here, as approach itself means 'to come near'.
6. Replace 'A moment delay' by 'A moment's delay'.
7. Replace 'censured' by 'censored'.
8. Here use of 'she' is superfluous. Hence replace 'she has been selected' by 'has been selected'.
9. Replace 'insure' by 'ensure'.
10. Replace 'when' by 'than'. As 'No sooner than' is a pure connective.
11. Say 'cash in on'
12. Say "difference" for "differences"
13. Say "People" for "peoples"
14. Write "Financing" for "to finance"
15. Say "appreciated" for "appreciating"
16. Insert 'the' before 'issues'
17. No error
18. Say 'needs'
19. Use 'when' in place of 'where'
20. Use 'heartedly' in place of 'hearted'
21. Say 'for themselves'
22. Remove 'that'
23. Use 'Being' in place of 'Much'
24. Write "than" for "when".
