It may be noted that, with the advent of modernity and the print culture, even though oral traditions continued to exist vibrantly in the public sphere, what came to be acknowledged as mainstream literature, was what was written in literary forms such as long and short fiction, poetry, drama. But then, there has been a constant give-and- take between the written and the oral, duly recognized right from the days of the epic formulation.
